VidaNet



My season with VidaNet has ended and it is time to begin the next chapter of life. Leading up to my departure from Costa Rica, I entered my busiest season yet—Vida Missions. Vida Missions (VM) is a ten-day program, mimicking the 10-month discipleship program, that provides youth groups with three days of training, five days of outreach, one fun day, and a travel day. As the VM program coordinator, I had spent the previous eight months, October 2023-May 2024 coordinating logistics between the US youth groups and the Costa Rican churches. All of the hard work and coordination within our staff team was put to the test as teams began to arrive on June 5.

A total of ten teams partnered with VidaNet this summer and we served twelve Costa Rican churches. Each team left with greater unity and experienced the Lord's presence in a culture distinct from their own. Many youth commented that they grew up believing that the Lord was real, but weren't convinced of it until they saw Him move this summer.

Please continue to pray for me as I navigate re-entry into the United States and jump straight into college. I will be starting classes on August 19. Please pray that I would grow in intimacy with the Lord and that I desire Him more, I would desire for Him to be glorified on campus. Pray for divine opportunities to share of the joy that I have found.

Thank you for faithfully partnering with me in prayer. The impact of your support has not been lost on me.
